

Discussion Questions

Surprise!: Message 1 – The Wisemen Nov. 21, 2021

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. What has surprised you about following Jesus? In other words, how is your life as a follower of Christ different than what you originally expected?
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss Matthew 2:1-12

- 1. Have someone retell this passage in their own words.
- 2. Why do you think King Herod was "deeply disturbed" (vs.3) when the magi told him they were looking for the "king of the Jews"?
- 3. What do you think the magi were expecting it to be like when they met Jesus?
 - How was reality different than their expectations?
 - How were their expectations met or exceeded by meeting Jesus?
- 4. Notice the magi's response to Jesus. How is this different than the response of Jesus' own people throughout his life?
- 5. How did the magi demonstrate a posture of humility in their meeting Jesus?
- 6. What does this passage reveal about God?
- 7. What does this passage reveal about people?

Application

- 1. When your expectations are unmet, how is your response similar and different from the magi?
- 2. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Everyone creates an 'I Will' statement)
- 3. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 4. How can we as a group bless someone in response to this passage?
