

A Beautiful Mess - Discussion Questions

1 Corinthians 6:12-20)

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. How would you characterize our culture's view of sexuality?
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 6:1-11

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. Paul quoted a Corinthian saying that "All things are permissible, but not all things are profitable" (6:12). Do you think this saying is true?
- 3. In this passage, what are Paul's arguments against sexual immorality? Which one is the most convincing to you?
- 4. In your mind, what is the connection between the "spiritual" and the "physical"?
- 5. What does it mean "your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit"? (vs.19)
- 6. How well have you been caring for your temple?
- 7. How do you feel about the statement in vs.19-20 that "You are not your own; you were bought with a price"?
- 8. What do you learn about people in this passage?
- 9. What do you learn about God in this passage?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Each person create an 'I Will' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this passage?
