

Discussion Questions – Living God's Story

1 Corinthians 7:25-40

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. Name something that competes with the Lord for your heart and time?
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?
- 4. Did you make an "I will" statement last week? How did you do?

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 7:26-31

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. Why do you think Paul encourages people to "stay where you are"?
 - A. Though the crises are different, is this good advice for your life right now? Why or why not?
- 3. What is Paul trying to say in vs.29-31?
- 4. What doe you think he means that the present world is passing away?
- 5. What do you learn about God from this passage?
- 6. What do you learn about people?
- 7. What stands out to you?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Each person create an 'I Will' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this passage?
