

Discovery Questions "Status for All" - 1 Cor. 11:2-16

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Opening Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. How does status (financial, race, gender, job, etc.) affect someone's influence or position in a church? Explain.
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 11:2-16

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out in this passage?
- 3. In the first century, women were considered men's property. How does Paul lift up women by comparing their relationship with men to the relationship Jesus has with the Father?
- 4. Pastor Don shared that he believes the best understanding of vss.4-10 is that Paul is restating the Corinthian's misunderstanding about women. Others believe Paul is giving the church a new law. What do you think?
- 5. Read verses 7-8 (the Corinthian view) and then read verses 11-12 (Paul's view). How does Paul begin to clear up their misunderstanding about the relationship between men and women?
- 6. What do you learn about God in this passage?
- 7. What do you learn about people in this passage?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Have each person create an 'I Will...' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this Scripture and discussion?
