Week 2: Competing Messiahs

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT TOGETHER (choose 1-2)

- 1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
- 2. How have you seen Jesus at work in the world around you? How have you been able to join him? Remember, God works through small stories.
- 3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
- 4. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?

READ Luke 23:13-25

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. Does anything happen in this passage that is different from what you typically would expect?
- 3. Does anything stand out as surprising, interesting, confusing, or powerful?
- 4. What other ironies do you see in this passage (ex. Barabbas means "Son of the Father" and Jesus is the Son of the Father)
- 5. How does Herod and Pilate's leadership and character contrast with Jesus?
- 6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 7. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

- 2. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
