

“Enough is Enough” Discussion Questions

5/12/24 – Pay It Forward

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT TOGETHER (choose 1-2)

1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
2. How have you seen Jesus at work in the world around you? How have you been able to join him? Remember, God works through small stories.
3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
4. From Sunday’s message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?

READ 1 Timothy 6:6-12, 17-19

1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
2. What stands out as significant, surprising, interesting, confusing, or powerful?
3. Can you share a story or example of where you struggle with the love for more money, more stuff, or more *something else*?
4. Do you consider yourself the “rich” person Paul is talking to? Why or why not?
5. How have you seen the pursuit of “more” lead to harm or even destruction?
6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
7. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

LIVE IT OUT

1. What are some specific ways we can apply Paul’s command to those who are rich (vs.17-18)?
2. What does it look like to you “to take hold of the life that is truly life”? (vs.19)
3. How is this passage calling our group to live out God’s mission to bless others?

PRAY
