# Life Group Questions

I Believe in God (Psalm 8)

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). It's good to begin with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

## **CONNECT Questions**

- 1. Read the first 3 lines of the Apostles Creed. Do you ever doubt the existence of God? Why?
- 2. What are some of the reasons you believe in God?
- 3. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 4. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 5. Are you participating in the Lent Prayer Guide? How is God working and speaking to you?

### READ Psalm 8:3-9

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out or is interesting to you?
- What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 4. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

### LIVE IT OUT

- 1. Pastor Don mentioned how intimate relationships require a leap or an "all-in" commitment. Do you agree?
- 2. In what specific ways can you pursue and respond to God this week?
