Life Group Questions

YHWH: Knowing God (Exodus 2:24-3:15)

Instructions: A life group is like family. It is a time of growing in Jesus together, caring for each other, and living out Jesus' mission together. It's good to begin with prayer and a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss using the provided questions as a guide. Make sure to conclude with an "I will" statement to apply the passage and finish with a time of prayer together.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. What is a question that you would ask God if you had the chance? What do you think his answer would be?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

READ Exodus 2:24-3:15

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out to you?
- 3. Why do you think God allowed the Israelites to suffer so long before rescuing them?
- 4. Why do you think God chose to work through Moses rather than rescuing the people on his own?
- 5. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)
- 6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)

LIVE IT OUT

- 1. Create an "I Will...' statement" about how you can live this out in the next few days.
- 2. During Lent (Feb.22-April 2), our church family will observe communion each week. Would your life group be willing to serve together one week? Sign up in the lobby.
- 3. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
