

Discovery Questions – Love Where You Live

1 Corinthians 13:1-13

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Opening Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. What was one of your favorite love songs as a teenager? Why did you like it?
- 2. Is there a challenge you are facing right now?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out in this passage?
- 3. How or when in your life have you felt the most loved or loved by? Explain.
- 4. How is Paul's understanding of "agape" different from how we typically define "love"?
- 5. In vss. 4-8, which characteristic(s) of love do you most struggle with? Explain.
- 6. What do you learn about God in this passage?
- 7. What do you learn about people in this passage?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Have each person create an 'I Will...' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this Scripture and discussion?
