

Life Group Questions

What is the Gospel? (1 Cor 15:1-11)

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Opening Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. How would you describe or define "the gospel"? How would you explain this in a sentence or two to someone who had never heard this word?
- 2. In your opinion, what are the essential beliefs to be a Christian?
- 3. Is there a challenge you are facing right now?
- 4. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out or interests you in this passage?
- 3. Why did people believe in the resurrection? How did they know it really happened? (vss. 5-8)
- 4. What would you add or take away from your earlier definition of "the gospel"?
 - 1. What does Paul mean by "according to the Scriptures"? In other words, what story is Jesus fulfilling?
 - 2. How would you summarize what the Gospel is NOT?
- 5. Do you think Christians today add to or change what the gospel actually is? Explain.
- 6. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)
- 7. What do you learn about people in this passage?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? In other words, what should "gospeling" look like in your life? (Create an 'I Will...' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this Scripture and discussion?
