Life Group Questions

Title (Scripture)

Instructions: A life group is like family. It is a time of growing in Jesus together, caring for each other, and living out Jesus' mission together. It's good to begin with prayer and the CONNECT questions to get to know one another and focus. Then read the Scriptures and discuss the questions. Make sure to conclude with an "I will" statement to apply the passage. Finish with a time of prayer together.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. Which picture best represents your prayer life? 1) A barren desert, 2) A flowing river, 3) A bored child, 4) Two friends sharing a coffee, or 5) Come up with your own. Explain.
- 2. What are you thankful for?
- 3. Is there a challenge you are facing right now?
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

READ Luke 5:15-16, 6:12-13, and John 17:20-21

- 1. Have someone summarize each of the passages...
- 2. What stands out to you?
- 3. In your opinion, why does Jesus go off and pray?
- 4. What does Jesus pray for?
- 5. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)
- 6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)

LIVE IT OUT

- 1. Pray together for God to open your eyes to what he is already doing.
- 2. Discuss together where you see God working around you (neighborhood, work, play)
- 3. Create an "I Will...' statement" how you can live this out in the next few days?
- 4. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
