Lavish: The Art of Being Grateful Discussion Questions

Grateful Giving

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. Do you think people are turned off when pastors talk about money? Why?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Are you facing a challenge right now?
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

READ 2 Corinthians 8:7-11, 9:6-8

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out, is surprising, or interesting to you?
- 3. Read 2 Corinthians 9:7 again. Is this different from what you have heard? Explain.
- 4. Why do you think Paul leaves it up to each person/family to decide what they give?
- 5. Pastor Don compared **Activity Giving** (Spontaneous giving that meets immediate needs) and **Foundation Giving** (Strategic giving that makes ongoing ministry possible).
 - a. Is one more important than the other?
 - b. Do you agree with Pastor Don that **Foundation Giving** is typically a more mature kind of giving? Explain.
- 6. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 7. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

- 1. How can you apply this passage this week? (Create an "I Will...' statement")
- 2. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
