Life Group Questions

It's About the Heart (2 Chronicles 30)

Instructions: A life group is like family. It is a time of growing in Jesus together, caring for each other, and living out Jesus' mission together. It's good to begin with prayer and a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss using the provided questions as a guide. Make sure to conclude with an "I will" statement to apply the passage and finish with a time of prayer together.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. What words often come to people's mind when they think about what God is like in the Old Testament? How do you reconcile that with God as portrayed through Jesus?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

READ 2 Chronicles 30:1-20

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out to you?
- 3. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)
- 4. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 5. In what ways is this picture of God in 2 Chronicles 30 like Jesus?

LIVE IT OUT

- 1. How can you apply this passage to your own life?
- 2. Pastor Don mentioned how the "Fruit to Root" tool (avalonchurch.org/fruit-to-root) helps expose misbeliefs about God and leads us to discover who God really is. Have you used this tool? If so, what was it like? If not, is this something you are willing to do?
- 3. Maybe consider doing a fruit to root together as a group the next time you meet.
- 4. Create an "I Will...' statement" about how you can live out this passage the next few days.
- 5. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
