Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Conclude with application and prayer.

CONNECT Questions (choose 1-2)

- 1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
- 2. Are you facing a challenge right now?

WORSHIP DISCUSSION

- 1. From Sunday's panel, share a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 2. Have different people read the following Scriptures:

- 4. Which scripture resonates most with you? Explain.
