

# **Discussion Questions**

# Confirmation

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

### **Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)**

- 1. Has your overall experience with "the church" been good, bad, or both? Explain.
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

#### Read and discuss Acts 9;20-28

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. What is the significance of Paul's finally being accepted by the church in Jerusalem? How did it impact Paul's future? How did it impact the church's future?
- 3. Has there been a Barnabas in your life? In other words, is there someone who has affirmed you, accepted you, and stood up for you when it could have cost them?

## Read and discuss 2 Corinthians 1:21-22

- 1. What does this passage say God does for those who stand firm in Christ? How would you describe this in your own words?
- 2. What do you learn about God in the above passages?
- 3. What do you learn about people in these passages?
- 4. "Confirmation" is the recognition by the church-family that the Holy Spirit is present and working in a person's life. How *does* the church and *should* the church recognize and affirm the Holy Spirit's presence and work in the lives of his people?

### **Application**

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Have each person create an 'I Will...' statement)
- 2. Are you making use of the Lenten Prayer Guide (avalonchurch.org/bulletin)? What is God saying to you through your time with him?
- 3. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 4. How can our group bless someone in response to this Scripture and discussion?
