Surprise!: Message 4 – Worth the Wait Dec.12, 2021

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. What is something you waited for a long time? Did you receive it? Was it worth the wait?
- 2. What is a challenge you are facing?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss Luke 1:26-38

- 1. Have someone retell this passage in their own words.
- 2. What do you learn about Jesus from the angel's announcement?
- 3. From what you know, how did Jesus fulfill the promises the angel said about him in Luke 1:31-33, 35?

<u>Read Together</u>: The Jews were expecting a Messiah that would bring justice, would free Israel from Roman rule, and would establish a good King from the line of David. In other words, Messiah would usher in the new age of God's Kingdom on earth.

- 4. Why do you think it was hard for people to believe Jesus was the Messiah? Would you have believed?
- 5. By the time Jesus was born, the Jewish people had waited over 600 years for their Messiah. What doubts and faith-issues do you think they experienced as a result?
- 6. What doubts and faith-issues have you experienced in the realization that God does not fulfill his promises the way you expect?
- 7. What does this passage reveal about God?
- 8. What does this passage reveal about people?

Application

- 1. Read Hebrews 12:1-3. What does it mean for you "strip off every weight that slows us down" (NLT)? How do you keep your eyes on Jesus in the midst of the struggle?
- 2. Read Revelation 21:3-4, a description of God's Kingdom fully realized. How much should this promise affect your daily life?

- 3. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Everyone creates an 'I Will' statement)
- 4. How can you bless someone else as a result of today's Scripture and discussion?
- 5. How can we as a group bless someone in response to this discussion?
