# **Life Group Questions**

## One Question Series - Should We Care About Social Justice?

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). It's good to begin with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

#### **CONNECT Questions**

- 1. What has needs injustices, and/or inequalities has God made you aware of concerning the world around you?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

#### **READ Isaiah 58:1-11**

- 1. Have someone retell the passage in their own words.
- 2. What stands out or is interesting to you?
- 3. How is social justice Good News to the world?
- 4. Why do you think God's people so often do not live out Good News to those who are suffering injustice and inequality?
- 5. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 6. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)

### **LIVE IT OUT**

- 1. What needs, injustices, and inequalities are you aware of in the world around you?
- 2. What is God speaking to your heart about concerning these needs?
- 3. How can you apply this passage this week? (Create an "I Will...' statement")
- 4. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
