<u>10-8-23 – Community Panel Discussion Questions</u>

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Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). Start with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. What is something you are thankful for this week?
- 2. From Sunday's panel, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Are you facing a challenge right now?

Read Philippians 2:1-11

- 1. Have everyone share in their own words various examples of what "COMMUNITY" looks like according to this passage.
- 2. What else stands out, is surprising, or interesting to you?
- 3. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)Which passage(s) most resonate with you? Explain.
- 4. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)
- 5. This passage paints a picture of community that is extremely difficult, if not impossible. What will it take for us to become the kind of community that reflects the character of Jesus?
- 6. In your opinion, is this kind of community really worth the effort necessary to create it?

- 1. How can you apply this week what you heard in the panel and read in Philippians 2:1-11?
- 2. What are some specific ways you can live out **COMMUNITY** in your life group?
