Life Group Questions

Who is the Holy Spirit?

Instructions: Life Group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). It's good to begin with 1-2 CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

CONNECT Questions

- 1. How has your view of the Holy Spirit been influenced by your upbringing?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

<u>READ Genesis 1:1-3, 41:37-40, Exodus 31:1-5, Isaiah 11:1-2, Ezekiel</u> <u>36:26-27, Matthew 1:18, Luke 3:22, Luke 4:18-19,</u> <u>Acts 2:1-4, 2 Corinthians 3:17-18</u>

- 1. Have a different person read each passage.
- 2. What stands out or is interesting to you about the Holy Spirit?
- 3. What kinds of things does the Holy Spirit do?
- 4. What do you learn about God in this passage? (his character, his ways, etc.)
- 5. What do you learn about people in this passage? (yourself, others)

LIVE IT OUT

- 1. In what ways is God's Spirit specifically working through you and us together to create life and bring New Creation?
- How can you apply this passage this week? (Create an "I Will...' statement")
- 3. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
