# **Life Group Questions**



## How Can I Know God's Will?

Instructions: A life group is a family growing in Jesus together (worship), caring for each other (community), and BLESSing our neighbors together (mission). It's good to begin with a couple of the CONNECT questions. Then read the Scriptures and discuss. Make sure to conclude by applying the passage and finishing with a time of prayer.

### **CONNECT Questions**

- 1. How has your life taken turns that you could not have predicted? What did you learn?
- 2. From Sunday's message, is there a thought or idea that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, or surprised you?
- 3. Share something you are thankful for or a challenge you are facing right now.
- 4. How did you do with your last "I Will" statement?

## **READ Read Romans 12:1-2**

- 1. Have someone rephrase the passage in their own words.
- 2. What teachable moments can you find in this passage?
- 3. What does it mean to offer our bodies as a living sacrifice? How does this prepare us to make wiser decisions?

#### Read Matthew 6:33-34

- 1. Explain in your own words what you think Jesus means.
- 2. Pastor Don mentioned that seeking God and his Kingdom first is our "goal." If we do this, even though some decisions may be wiser than others, we can still be confident that we are in his will. Do you agree? Explain.
- 3. After this discussion, how would you explain we discern God's will?

## **LIVE IT OUT**

- 1. Are you facing any decisions right now where you are trying to determine God's will? Explain.
- 2. How can you apply these passages this week? (Create an "I Will...' statement")
- 3. How is this passage calling our group to live out God's mission to bless others?
