

Discussion Questions – "Pride or Power?" 1 Corinthians 4:1-21

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are</u> <u>of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. Has anyone subscribed to the devotions at "MyDailyBriefing.org"? What are your thoughts?
- 2. Has your pride ever got the best of you? Share your story.
- 3. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 4. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 4:5-16

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. Paul is specifically addressing their pride (vs 6) that has led to their division and posture of being ungrateful. Look through verses 7-13,
 - 1. What are some issues through which their pride is being revealed?
 - 2. How are Paul and Apollos different?
- 3. In your opinion, why would Paul say "Imitate me?"
- 4. Who in your life, by way of their example, has challenged you to live a better life?
- 5. What do you learn about people in this passage?
- 6. What do you learn about God in this passage?

Application

- How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Each person create an 'I Will' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this passage?
