

A Beautiful Mess - Discussion Questions

1 Corinthians 5:1-8

Instructions: A life group is a spiritual family. It is a time of mutual discussion, invitation, and growth together alongside the Holy Spirit. It's good to begin with prayer and 1-2 ice breaker questions to prime the pump and get to know one another. Then, after reading the Scriptures, <u>pick the questions that are of most interest to your group</u>. Make sure to conclude with a couple of application questions to live out our mission together. Finish with some time to care for one another and pray together.

Ice Breaker Question (pick 1-2 questions)

- 1. What is a challenge you are facing right now?
- 2. Have you even seen a church split over scandal? How did it affect your faith?
- 3. What is one thought or idea from Sunday's message that especially intrigued, provoked, disturbed, challenged, encouraged, warmed, warned, helped, or surprised you?

Read and discuss 1 Corinthians 5:1-8

- 1. Have someone summarize this passage in their own words.
- 2. What could cause the church and the man committing incest to be so proud?
- 3. With all the issues that the church faced back then (and today), why is pride such a big issue that Paul said to remove the man from the church?
- 4. Don mentioned some cultural issues that played a big role in Paul's instruction to separate from the man. In our culture, how might scandals and pride like this be handled today?
- 5. Read vs. 5 again. What is the purpose of the discipline?
- 6. In vs.8, Paul is using a Passover metaphor to encourage them to live out their identity in Christ. In your opinion, what does this look like?

Application

- 1. How can you specifically live out this passage in the next few days? (Each person create an 'I Will' statement)
- 2. How can you bless someone else as a result of this Scripture and discussion?
- 3. How can our group bless someone in response to this passage?
